**UPDATE NOTICE TO RESIDENTS - SEWER REHABILITATION**

The Town of New Windsor would like to provide our residents and businesses with an update on the status of the sewer lining project in which you were informed in our letter dated July 13, 2017.

Due to some technical issues experienced by our vendor, we have had to amend the week 2 schedule and added 2 days for a partial week 3. Please refer to the amended table below for an approximate schedule of affected areas by day for the remainder of the project.

<b>Monday, July 24, 2017</b>	High St. between Maple St. and Church St.
<b>Tuesday, July 25, 2017</b>	Main St. between Manning Dr. and MD75/Union Bridge Rd.
<b>Wednesday, July 26, 2017</b>	Main St. between 210 Main St. and Water St.
<b>*Thursday, July 27, 2017</b>	205 Church to High St. (2PM) High St. to 121 Church St. (9PM) Main St between Springdale Ave and Blue Ridge Ave (2AM)
<b>Monday, July 31, 2017</b>	High St. between Coe Dr. and Maple Ave.
<b>Tuesday, August 1, 2017</b>	MD75/Union Bridge Rd., Manning Dr. to Main St.

Please note that if any further obstacles arise during the project this schedule may change slightly. We will continue to update the Town website ([newwindsor.md.gov](http://newwindsor.md.gov)) daily through project completion. You will be directly notified within 48 hours when the process will affect your residence or business via a door hanger placed upon your front door.

**Important notes to remember:**

**Installation of the CIPP will temporarily block your sewer connection.** Please limit or reduce the amount of water discharged to the sewer, including toilet flushing, dish and clothes washing and use of your sump pump. Excessive use of the sewer service (e.g., more than 3 toilet flushes) may result in a backup into your home/building. Any sump pump should be turned off or the outflow redirected if use is absolutely necessary. Water service will not be affected however, DO NOT flush water or pour water down drains during the work day in your area. You may resume normal sewer use once the installation trucks are gone unless otherwise advised from the installation crew.

It is strongly advised to have additional water (i.e. water bottles, jugs, etc...) on reserve while work is being done in your section of town.

**NOTE: FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE PROCEDURES CAN DAMAGE THE SEWER LINER BEING INSTALLED AND WILL RESULT IN SEWAGE BACKING UP INTO YOUR HOME/BUILDING LINE AND POSSIBLY INTO YOUR HOME/BUILDING.**

**Construction:**

You may notice some noise from truck engines, pumps and other equipment and possible work lights if any night work is required. Anticipated time of work is from 7:00am – 3:00pm.

**Traffic & Parking:**

Changes in traffic patterns along this route will be posted.
