

INVITATION TO BID

The Town of New Windsor, Carroll County, MD is requesting bids from qualified contractors for the construction of the project known as "BLUE RIDGE AND COLLEGE AVENUES ROAD IMPROVEMENTS".

The work generally consists of pavement, curb and gutter removal and reconstruction, clearing and grubbing, milling, paving, curb, sidewalk, storm drainage, pavement markings and signage, maintenance of traffic, relocation of existing utilities, retaining wall, cheek wall, concrete steps, driveway entrances, handicap ramps, sediment and erosion control and related work. The project location is College Avenue and Blue Ridge Avenue a distance of approximately 1200 feet in length.

- Attendance at the pre-bid meeting and site visit are not required, but it is recommended.
- Questions in writing will be accepted until 2:00 P.M., EST time, Friday, October 19, 2018.
- Sealed Bids will be received by the Owner at the address shown above until 10:00 A.M., EST, Friday, October 26, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.
- Bidding Documents may be examined without charge at the Office of the Owner.
- Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained at the Office of the Owner for a fee of \$125 per set. Payment for purchasing Bidding Documents shall be made only by check, or money order; payment by cash is not acceptable. Deposit will become the property of the Owner and no deposits will be returned.
- Reproduction of the Bidding Documents, or their placement on web sites of prospective bidders and other entities, is not permitted.
- Bids may be modified or withdrawn by an appropriate document duly executed (in the manner that a Bid must be executed) and delivered to the place where Bids are to be submitted at any time prior to the opening of Bids.
