ORDINANCE NO.: _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NEW WINDSOR TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET AND THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR THE USE OF THE TOWN FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023, AND TO FURTHER PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF SAID TAXES AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST AND PENALTIES ACCRUING THEREON, IN ACORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF NEW WINDSOR AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TITLE 5 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Town of New Windsor that the budget prepared by the Town Council and attached hereto, and made a part hereof, for the period July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, be, and it is hereby adopted and approved.

SECTION 2: **Real Property** – AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED that a tax of Twenty-six and fifteen hundredths Cents (\$0.2615) on every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value of all real property within the corporate limits of the Town of New Windsor, Carroll County, Maryland, be levied for the use of the Town of New Windsor for the period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 for general purposes, as authorized by the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Section C7-12 through C7-14 of the Charter of the Town of New Windsor and as further authorized by Title 5 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED that said taxes so levied shall be collected by Carroll County. Taxes shall be overdue on the dates established by the Carroll County Commissioners. They shall bear interest and be subject to penalty in the amounts specified from time to time for taxes due to Carroll County, Maryland. All taxes not paid and in arrears shall be collected as provided by Section C7-15 and C7-16 of the Charter and by Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 4: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED that the tax collector of said Town be and is hereby authorized, directed and required to collect the taxes levied by this Ordinance and the interest and penalties accruing thereon, in accordance with the aforementioned authorities; and said tax collector shall give notice, by publication in a newspaper of general circulation, and posting a notice thereof in the Town Office, of the time said taxes shall be due and payable and to who, and when they may be paid.

SECTION 5: Personal Property – AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED that a tax of Forty Cents (\$0.40) on every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed value of all personal and mixed property within the corporate limits of the Town of New Windsor, Carroll County, Maryland, be levied for the use of the Town of New Windsor for the period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 for general purposes, as authorized by the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Section C7-12 through C7-14 of the Charter of the Town of New Windsor and as further authorized by Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 6: Effective Date.
