## Announcement: Leaf Pickup

### Leaf Pickup began on November 6th, 2023

To ensure the successful pickup of your leaves, please place them in bags or cans. In the event your scheduled pickup date has passed, call Town Hall to arrange a one-time pickup date. **Moving forward leaves must be placed curbside in proper containers and on the day of scheduled pick up for your area. NO leaves will be picked up loose or in plastic bags.**

### No More Vacuuming of Leaves

The Town will no longer vacuum leaves. In prioritizing the safety of our Public Works Staff and investing in equipment that can be utilized for the majority of the year, we have adopted a new process. A street sweeper has been acquired to collect naturally falling leaves and debris year-round. Unlike the leaf vacuum, operational for only 2 months, the street sweeper can be used for 9 months annually.

### New Leaf Collection Process

Our updated method involves collecting leaves placed in bags and cans on designated days as outlined in our schedule. The new method mirrors our yard waste pickup process.

### Collection Schedule

**MONDAY:** Church Street, Lambert Avenue, Maple Avenue, Hillside Drive, and High Street

**TUESDAY:** College Avenue, Blue Ridge Avenue, North side of Main Street in the rear on Manning Drive, South side of Main Street in the rear of Spoerlein Drive, properties facing Route 75, Main Street from 100 Block to Church Street

**WEDNESDAY:** Atlee Ridge Road, Jo Apter Place, Kaylan Court, Kelsey Court, Overleigh Way, and Vista Court

**THURSDAY:** Blue Ridge – Graybill Court, Murphy Court, Miles Court, Clauser Court, Gullo Road, 103 – 113 Springdale Avenue corporate limits.

### Designated Collection Days

To facilitate a smooth leaf pickup process, please adhere to the designated collection days for your area. A reminder: leaves will not be picked up if they are not in proper containers nor will they be picked up on Town observed Holidays.
