April 21, 2025

<u>Call to Order of Regular Work Session in person:</u> Mayor Roop called to order the April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025, meeting at 7:00 p.m.

<u>Present in person:</u> Mayor Roop, Vice president and Councilmember Kimberlee Schultz, Councilmembers, Kevin Cornick, Dave Hoffman, Connor Frock and William Holl were present. Also, present Town Attorney Ostrander and Public Works Director Myers.

<u>Approval of Meeting Minutes:</u> A Motion by Councilmember Schultz to approve March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025, minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilmember Cornick and approved by a vote of 5-0.

## AGENDA ITEMS:

- FY26 Budget Review
  - No change since the April Council meeting
  - General Capital Reserve Transfer of \$213,640 to balance General Fund
  - Enterprise Capital Reserve Transfer of \$417,500 to balance Enterprise Fund
- Water and Sewer Rate Resolution and Rate Schedule
  - Town Attorney to move forward with Resolution
- Public Works Director Updates
  - MSF Permit
    - The Town remains in compliance with MS4 requirements and implementing brine usage is not necessary at this time.
    - Currently in year 3 of a 5-year permit.
  - F-250 New Truck Purchase
    - Apple Ford \$68,258.84, Crouse Ford \$81,288, Gene Latta Ford \$80,038.80, Lindsy Ford \$81,717.

A motion by Councilmember Holl to purchase from Apple Ford F-250 for \$68,258.84. It was  $2^{nd}$  by Councilmember Frock and approved by a 5-0 vote.

A motion by Councilmember Cornick, to split the cost of the F-250 from Apple Ford between the General Fund and Enterprise Fund and if necessary, pull funds from the reserve. It was  $2^{nd}$  by Councilmember Schultz and approved by a 5-0 vote.

- UTV Purchase
  - Pete Cycle \$46,833.78, Ripon of Westminster \$33,616.69, Metro Bob-Cat \$42,255.06.
  - UTV Budget was \$30,000, lowest bid is over by \$3,616.69
  - Council to review information and discuss at the next Council Meeting
- Renewal of Matured CD
  - \$250,000 matured with Sandy Springs-original CD was 8 months at 4.63%
  - Farmers & Merchants 5 months at 4%, 13 months at 3.74%, Woodsboro Bank 5 months at 3.30%, 9 months at 2.99%, ACNB 6-month TBill at 3.85%, 1-year TBill at 3.65%- and 2-year TBill at 3.53%

A motion by Councilmember Cornick to invest \$250,000 in a CD with Farmers & Merchants at 4% for 5 months. It was  $2^{nd}$  by Councilmember Hoffman and approved by a 5-0 vote.
