TOWN OF NEW WINDSOR

RESOLUTION NO. 05-07-25A

WHEREAS, by virtue of the authority contained in <u>Local Government</u> Article 5-101 *et seq* of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Section 205-37 of the Code of the Town of New Windsor, the Mayor and Council are authorized to establish a schedule of fees for the public water and sewer systems within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NEW WINDSOR:

- ARTICLE 1. That water service rates for fiscal year 2026, July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 shall be as follows:
- A. 1. All service connections shall be assessed and charged a quarterly Base Unit Charge of One Hundred, Two Dollars (\$102.00).
- 2. All users of the system shall be charged a Water Usage Rate of Nine Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$9.50) per One thousand (1,000) gallons of water used, up to Twenty Thousand (20,000) gallons per quarter.
- 3. All users of the system shall be charged a Water Usage Rate of Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water used over Twenty Thousand (20,000) gallons per quarter.
- B. In any two-family or multi-family building, each dwelling unit shall be assessed a separate Base Unit Charge.
- C. The water service rates for fiscal year 2027 and beyond shall be evaluated during preparation of each fiscal year budget.
- ARTICLE 2. That sewer service rates for fiscal year 2026, July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 shall be as follows:
- A. 1. All service connections shall be assessed and charged a quarterly Base Unit Charge of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 2. All users of the system shall be charged a Sewer Usage Rate of Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons up to Twenty Thousand (20,000) gallons of sewage produced per quarter.
- 3. All users of the system shall be charged a Sewer Usage Rate of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons over Twenty Thousand (20,000) gallons of sewage produced per quarter.

- B. In any two-family or multi-family building, each dwelling unit shall be assessed a Separate Base Unit Charge.
- C. The sewer service rates for fiscal year 2027 and beyond shall be evaluated during preparation of each fiscal year budget.
- **ARTICLE 3.** That the Water Connection Fee for each new residential and non residential user (Equivalent Dwelling Unit EDU) shall be as follows:
 - A. 1. For July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 \$10,550/EDU
 - 2. For July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 \$10,867/EDU
 - 3. For July 1, 2027 through June 30, 2028 \$11,192/EDU
 - 4. For July 1, 2028 through June 30, 2029 \$11,528/EDU
 - 5. For July 1, 2029 through June 30, 2030 \$11,874/EDU
- B. After July 1, 2030, the Water Connection Fee for each new residential and non -residential user (Equivalent Dwelling Unit EDU) shall automatically increase at a rate of Three Percent (3%) annually.
- **ARTICLE 4.** That the Sewer Connection Fee for each new residential and non-residential user(Equivalent Dwelling Unit EDU) shall be as follows:
 - A. 1. For July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 \$8,573/EDU
 - 2. For July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 \$8,830/EDU
 - 3. For July 1, 2027 through June 30, 2028 \$9,095/EDU
 - 4. For July 1, 2028 through June 30, 2029 \$9,368/EDU
 - 5. For July 1, 2029 through June 30, 2030 \$9,649/EDU
- B. After July 1, 2030, the Sewer Connection Fee for each new residential and non -residential user (Equivalent Dwelling Unit EDU) shall automatically increase at a rate of Three Percent (3%) annually.
- ARTICLE 5. The Mayor and Council may establish by Resolution any additional charges for delinquent payments, as well as disconnection and reconnection fees.

ARTICLE 6. Applicability.

This Resolution shall apply to all connections to public water and sewer service in existence on July 1, 2025 or thereafter established.

ARTICLE 7. Effective date.

This Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
