As we nestle in for the cold winter months, I'd like to take a moment to reflect on what an incredible year it has been for our beautiful town. From our vibrant local events to the tireless efforts of our volunteers and businesses, New Windsor continues to grow stronger, united, and full of hope for the future. I'd like to extend a special thank you to the residents who helped make the **Mayor on the Square Food and Coat Drive** an immense success. We collected over 30 cases of food and toiletries, five bags of coats and clothing, and nearly \$700 in monetary donations. All donations went to benefit the New Windsor Food Pantry at St. Paul United Methodist Church.

Winter brings its own set of challenges, but also moments of joy and connection. Whether it's the glow of our holiday lights, the warmth of community gatherings, or the simple pleasure of a snow-covered landscape, there is much to be grateful for during this time of year.

As we enter the colder months, I encourage everyone to be mindful of each other's well-being. This season is a perfect opportunity to check in on our neighbors, especially those who may need extra assistance with winter weather, or those who may have spent the holidays alone. Our town's spirit of kindness and support has always been one of its most beautiful qualities.

We also recognize that winter can be a challenging time in terms of safety. Our Public Works team is ready to keep our streets clear and safe. To assist their efforts, the Town asks that you abide by the snow emergency route plans when they are implemented. We also urge everyone to take extra care when navigating sidewalks and roadways during icy conditions.

Looking ahead, we have a number of exciting projects and initiatives planned for the coming year. Our commitment to improving local infrastructure, supporting small businesses, and enhancing public spaces remains unwavering. Just this past month, we received notice that New Windsor has been awarded a grant of **\$1,500** from the **Maryland Heritage Authority and Heart of the Civil War Heritage Area** for a sign to be created and installed at the Sulphur Spring House. We are also optimistically waiting for news on our **Community Legacy and Strategic Demolition** grant application to help fund the renovation of 211 High Street. We anticipate the



notification very soon. We're also excited for the kick-off of our inaugural New Windsor Small Business Round Table meeting in January.

In closing, I am deeply proud of all that we've accomplished together, and I know that in the year ahead, we will continue to make New Windsor an even better place to call home.

NEW! - Town of New Windsor Emergency Alerts

If you wish to receive Town of New Windsor emergency alerts (e.g. water main breaks) via text message and/or email, you must sign up. Currently, voice alerts are NOT an option.

Go to www.newwindsormd.gov and click on "Pay Bills" in the upper right-hand corner. Login to your account and click "My Profile" at the top right, then select settings.

Here you must edit your profile to add your email and/or cell phone number.

You will see the ALERT PREFERENCES at the bottom of that same page. To ensure you receive all types of messages, please check the High, Standard and Low severity boxes and then save.

If you do not have an account created, please create one and follow the above instructions.

Water & Sewer Updates

Friendly reminder - Please do not put food debris (cooking oils, grease, coffee grounds, etc.) or solids (flushable wipes, feminine hygiene products) down the drain or toilet. These items can clog the Town's sewage system leading to costly repairs.

Snow Emergency Routes

The Town Code states parking is prohibited on designated Town Snow Emergency Routes whenever a Snow Emergency has been declared by the State Highway Administration or the Maryland State Police. Parking is prohibited until the Snow Emergency is lifted and the streets are cleared of snow. The parking prohibition applies to all vehicles including towed vehicles such as trailers and campers. Having the streets clear of parked vehicles during snow events allows the Town crews to clear the snow quickly and is safe for both Town residents and staff.

When a snow emergency is declared by the State Highway Administration, the Town of New Windsor will post the declaration on the Town's Website and Facebook page. Please remember to stay educated during snow events.

Whenever you hear the weatherman call for snow, play it safe and just remove your vehicle from the street so you are not burdened later with cost associated with violations.

Please check the Town’s website and Facebook page for additional information and updates during a Snow Emergency.

Park cars in driveways: Parking cars in the driveway will allow snow plows to clear the snow more quickly, get streets plowed as wide as possible and avoid the possibility of damaging cars.

Clear sidewalks within 24 hours of the end of the snow: Clearing the sidewalks is the responsibility of the property owner. Town code requires the sidewalks to be cleared within 24 hours of the end of the snow.

Snow maintenance around fire hydrants: If you have a fire hydrant near your house, please keep it clear of snow so the fire department can quickly access it during an emergency.

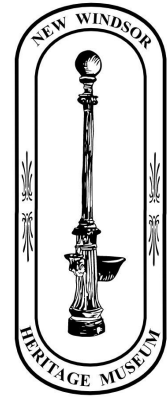

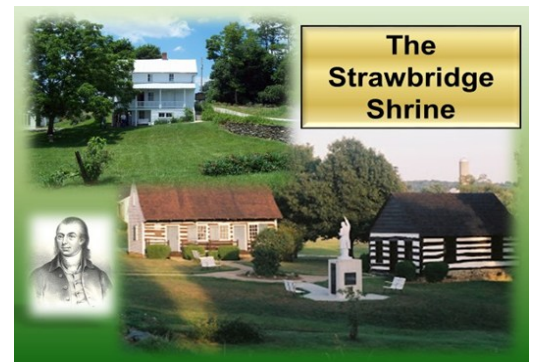

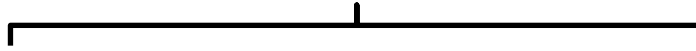
