As the flowers begin to bloom and the days grow longer, it is a pleasure to welcome another beautiful spring in our historic town. This season is a time of renewal, and I am thrilled to share significant news regarding our town's infrastructure and upcoming community celebrations.



Federal Grant Update

I am proud to announce that the Town of New Windsor has been awarded a **\$500,000 federal grant** for critical upgrades to our Wastewater Treatment Plant. This successful application represents a major win for our community, allowing us to modernize aging equipment and improve water quality without placing the financial burden on our residents. These enhancements are vital for ensuring our town's long-term sustainability and environmental health. The Town was informed of this award by offices of Congressman Johnny Olszewski and Senator Chris Van Hollen.

State Grant Update

I am equally as proud to announce that the Town of New Windsor has received a Statewide Strategic Demolition Fund grant from the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) through the Division of Neighborhood Revitalization. This grant will be utilized to continue the Structural Stabilization Pre-Construction project at the Historic Dielman Inn.

YARD WASTE PICK UP - Begins Thursday, April 9

Collection Reminders:

1. Yard waste can be put in brown paper yard waste bags (can be purchased at Walmart, Lowes or Home Depot).
2. Yard waste can be put into cans. Please make sure lids fit and holes are drilled in the bottom of the can for drainage. Please, NO cans that are broken and/or have sharp edges.
2. Tree limbs can NOT exceed more than 4 feet long and 4 inches in diameter and must be tied into bundles.
3. Please NO DOG WASTE or trash mixed into yard waste!!



Dates on the calendars are firm unless an emergency or inclement weather occurs. Rain dates will be on the following Monday.

BULK TRASH DAY - Rain or Shine!

Saturday, APRIL 25 - 8 am - 12 pm

- Bulk trash is for large items that cannot go with regular trash, with the exceptions of paint cans, concrete, tires and building materials.
- Accepting bulk metal, such as appliances, lawn mowers, etc.
- If residents wish to recycle computers and electronics, you will need to take the items to the recycling center at the County Landfill. If not, they will be thrown in with the regular bulk trash.
- Bulk trash must be brought to the Public Works facility located on Geer Lane. Identification will be required to show proof that you reside within town limits.
- Please call the Town Office with any questions of what we can accept at Bulk Trash.



TRASH & RECYCLING PICK-UP WEDNESDAY EACH WEEK UNLESS SPECIFIED ON THE TOWN CALENDAR

- Your trash must be set out the night before to ensure pick up.
- Each stop may have up to 3 trash containers of household refuse per week with each container limited to 25 pounds.
- Each stop may also have up to 3 recycle toters per week with each toter limited to 25 pounds.

Water & Sewer Updates

Reminder - All water/sewer payments are due on the 20th of the billing month. For example, water/sewer invoices issued January 1 are due by January 20, unless a resident enrolls in the Installment Plan.

If a resident is enrolled in the Installment Plan, water/sewer payments will be due on the 20th of each month following the invoice being issued. For example, water/sewer invoices issued January 1 will be due on January 20, February 20 and March 20. See below for Installment Plan Agreement Application instructions.

Late fees will no longer be assessed to delinquent accounts. However, if your water service is interrupted, the turn-on fee is now \$100.

Installment Plan Agreement Application

At the February 4, 2026, Town Council meeting, the Council approved a new policy regarding monthly payments (installment payments). An Installment Plan Agreement Application must be completed and signed by all residents who wish to pay or are already paying their waste/sewer invoices monthly. For your convenience, we have included a copy in this newsletter. Complete the form and send it back to Town Hall at your earliest convenience. You may leave it in the secure lock box outside the front door of Town Hall as well. We appreciate your cooperation!

NEW! - Town of New Windsor Emergency Alerts

Be sure not to miss any announcements from Town Hall - Sign up for Emergency Alerts now! (water main breaks, weather related closure, etc.)

We currently have 44% of residents enrolled in the emergency alert system. Thank you to everyone who has signed up! We will begin sending alerts once we receive 50% participation.

Fire Hydrant Flushing

The Department of Public Works expects to be conducting fire hydrant flushing throughout the Town in **May**. This process **affects all residents on the Town's public water system**. When the flushing occurs, it will take place on **weekdays between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM** until the process is complete. Once a definite date is determined, the Town will post the flushing schedule on its website and Facebook page. For more information, contact Town Hall at 410.635.6575.



When the flushing occurs, you can expect:

- You may experience temporary **water discoloration**. If this occurs, run **cold water** from all faucets until it clears.
- To avoid inconvenience, **fill containers with water the night before** for drinking, cooking, and other morning needs.
- **Always test cold water first** before using hot water to prevent discolored water from entering your hot water system.
- Even if discolored, the water remains **safe and fully treated** for consumption.
- After flushing, **replace water filters and clean faucet aerators** as needed.



We will resume our **regular Saturday hours beginning on May 2**, when the museum will be open from **10 am to 1 pm**.






