comply with the Qualified Voter and Primary Residence requirements.

Town Charter – Article 3 - §C3-2 – Qualifications

Councilmembers shall have resided in the Town for at least two years immediately preceding their election and shall
be qualified voters of the Town. They shall maintain a permanent residence in the Town during their term of office.

Town Charter – Article 4 - §C4-2 – Qualifications

The Mayor must have resided in the Town for at least two years immediately preceding his or her election, must be a
qualified voter of the Town, and must maintain a permanent residence in the Town during his or her term.

“Qualified Voter” means that you are a citizen of the United States, are eighteen (18) years of age on or before election day,
have resided in the State of Maryland for at least one (1) year next preceding any Town election, have resided within the
corporate limits of the Town for six (6) months next preceding any Town election.

“Primary Residence” means the residence maintained at the location in which the individual is domiciled. “Domicile”, the
place where an individual has his or her true, fixed, and permanent home residence.
